LEGAL NOTICE OF TERMINATION FROM MEDICARE PROGRAM

Effective on March 31, 2024, the Secretary of the Department of Health & Human Services will terminate its Medicare Provider Agreement with Nova Hospice Care, Inc. A Medicare complaint validation survey conducted on November 16, 2023, found Nove Hospice Care, Inc. was not in compliance with requirements for participation in the Medicare and Medicaid programs as established by the Social Security Act (Section 1861) and its underlying regulations.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services CMS) has determined that Nova Hospice Care, Inc. was not in compliance with the following two Medicare Conditions of Participation for Hospice services:

42 C.F.R. § 418.52 Patients' Rights 42 C.F.R. § 418.102 Medical Director

Medicare and Medicaid programs will not make payments for services furnished to patients who were admitted on or after March 31, 2024. For patients admitted prior to March 31, 2024, payment may be available for up to thirty (30) calendar days after the effective date of termination.
