### **Notice to Public of Revocation of Quantox Lab's CLIA Certificate, 26D2135849**

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that on **June 2, 2023**, the Quantox Lab's laboratory 4633 World Parkway Circle St. Louis, MO 63134 CLIA certificate was revoked due to unremoved immediate jeopardy.

The facility has been notified that the CLIA certificate was revoked on **June 2, 2023**. When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is revoked, it is required to cease all patient laboratory testing, including waived and provider-performed microscopy testing and regardless of whether or not the laboratory charges for the testing. CMS is committed to patient safety and quality of care.
