Out-of-Pocket Limits for Medigap Plans K & L for Calendar Year 2022

Summary:

The 2022 out-of-pocket (OOP) limits for Medigap plans K & L are \$6,620 and \$3,310, respectively. These increases in the limits are based on estimates of the United States Per Capita Costs (USPCC) of the Medicare program developed by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

Calculation of the OOP Annual Limits:

The annual OOP limits are determined in accordance with section 1882(w)(2) of the Social Security Act. That provision prescribed an OOP limit for 2006 of \$4,000 for Plan K and \$2,000 for Plan L, and directed that these amounts increase each subsequent year by an appropriate inflation adjustment specified by the Secretary of the United States Department of Health & Human Services. For 2022 the calculation of the OOP limits is based on estimates of the United States Per Capita Costs (USPCC) of the Medicare program developed by CMS as published with the announcement of Calendar Year (CY) 2021 and CY 2022 Medicare Advantage (MA) payment rates.

The inflation adjustment for 2022 is calculated by applying the percentage increase from 2021 to 2022 of the current estimates of the Total USPCC – non-ESRD for Medicare Part A and Part B to the 2021 OOP limits. An adjustment is made to account for corrections to prior years' estimates.
