



Resources for Medicare Providers About MyCare Ohio

Dear Ohio Medicare Provider,

You may have recently heard about a new Ohio medical care program, MyCare Ohio. In MyCare Ohio, beneficiaries have the opportunity to receive both Medicare and Medicaid coverage from a single, integrated Medicare-Medicaid plan. Beneficiaries who choose to receive their Medicare and Medicaid services through MyCare Ohio are participating in a demonstration designed to integrate care for Ohio beneficiaries who are dually eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid. The demonstration is jointly administered by the federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Ohio Department of Medicaid.

MyCare Ohio operates in seven regions around the state and beneficiaries are required to enroll in a plan for their Medicaid services. Individuals have the option of enrolling for their Medicare benefits or else opting out and selecting another Medicare care model. Each region has a minimum of two MyCare Ohio plans from which beneficiaries may choose. Providers are encouraged to consider joining the networks of one or more MyCare Ohio plans operating in their region in order to provide continuous care to eligible beneficiaries.

Most providers may continue to see beneficiaries who chose to receive both Medicare and Medicaid through MyCare Ohio during the transition period. The following links provide additional details on provider payment and participation in MyCare Ohio.
